University Medical Center Patient Tower

Harris, Inc. began the 77,000-square-foot four-story patient tower. Several technological enhancements are featured within the tower such as state of the art nursing stations accompanied by satellite charting stations and bar code medication administration. A pneumatic tube system and bariatric lifts are also featured in the new patient tower. These features will add safety and efficiency for our patients, as will the new nurse call system.

In addition to the enhanced technology, the new patient tower has been developed with growth in mind. The ground floor is not only home to the Outpatient Rehab/Physical Therapy and Sports Medicine departments, but features additional support spaces.

Moving up to the first floor, known as the 'Surgical Floor', you enter the facility's Orthopedic Center of Excellence. For convenience and continuity of flow, this floor connects directly to the Emergency Department, Radiology and Surgical areas. The third floor of the facility features more of the sixty new private patient rooms. As an added benefit they offer ease of access with a new entry/drop-off area located on the north side of the UMC campus. The top floor of the new facility is shelled space that will be put to good use in the anticipation of Wilson County's continued growth.
